Led by international scholars, this real-time remote conference will enable discussions surrounding research and community activities.

Participating institutes will host their respective conferences, starting at 7AM EST, to be broadcast live by BSI. To establish an accessible platform, BSI is willing to provide funds to support internet and webinar connections. Links for the live broadcast will be distributed to all registered participants prior to the conference.

Interested undergraduate and graduate students and trainees are invited to submit Abstracts related to these topics spanning basic/fundamental research to translational/clinical work and population health.

In addition, we invite registrants to submit a '**BSI Hot Doc**' – a 5 to 15 minute video that either (i) illustrates the social and cultural contexts of your research or (ii) describes how you center values of equity, social justice and community engagement in your work.
