Postdoctoral Position in Tumor Immunology / Immunotherapy

A joint postdoctoral position is available starting January 1st or later in the Laboratories of Dr. David Brooks and Dr. Tracy McGaha at the Princess Margaret Cancer Center. The postdoctoral fellow will study the mechanisms of immunosuppression and hypoxia that limit innate and adaptive immune responses in the tumor microenvironment. They will then use this information to design combination therapeutic vaccination and immunotherapeutic strategies to fight cancer.

Requirements: Candidates should have a background in cellular and/or molecular immunology with experience in tumor immunology. Candidates must be highly motivated, possess excellent communication skills and a strong record of scientific accomplishments, (including publications in peer-reviewed journals).
